COVID-19 Vaccinations: Three things you need to know.

- Who is eligible for the vaccination.
- Where to get the vaccination.
- How to get an appointment.

To find out this information, go to the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) website.

Click on "Find a Vaccine Provider near you", or call <u>1-866-365-8110</u> for answers to vaccine related questions and to obtain help finding the contact information you will need to schedule an appointment.

Reminders for getting your COVID-19 vaccine:

- Make an appointment with a vaccine provider to guarantee you'll receive your shot.
- You will need to make two appointments to receive one shot at each. This applies to both vaccines, Pfizer-BioNtech and Moderna.

- You should make your appointment for your second shot at the same location where you receive your first shot.
- Make your second appointment while you are at your first appointment, not later. Do not leave your first appointment without knowing how and when you will get your second shot.
- Until more vaccine is available, some appointments may need to be rescheduled for a later date if a provider runs out of vaccine. Providers will contact you directly if they need to reschedule your appointment.
- If you need to reschedule an appointment, remember to cancel your initial appointment so someone else can use it.
